We would like to invite you to apply for the inaugural International Real Estate Society (IRES) Doctoral Student Fellowship program that will be held between October and November 2021.

Capitalising on the success of the 2020 IRES Virtual Symposium for Doctoral Students, a pilot Fellowship program has been designed to facilitate the development of research skills among real estate doctoral students. In this program, students will have the opportunity to (1) network with other doctoral students, (2) learn research strategies from senior academics, and (3) prepare a draft of a research paper for presentation at an academic conference under the guidance of a mentor.

The Fellowship program runs over eight weeks and includes five, one-hour sessions held fortnightly beginning with a plenary session in early October (dates TBA). At each meeting students will hear from senior academics speaking on a variety of topics related to research development. There will also be opportunities to share ideas with other students as well as an academic mentor.

If accepted into the program, student participants will commit to:

- attending five online program sessions (one plenary and four sessions),
- meeting with a mentor and/or mentoring group at least once during the program,
- posting a recorded research presentation and commenting on videos posted by other participants, and
- preparing a draft paper to be submitted for consideration at an academic conference. Mentors will provide feedback.
